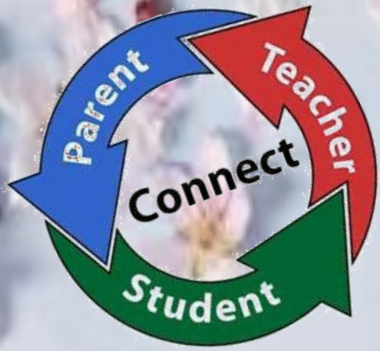

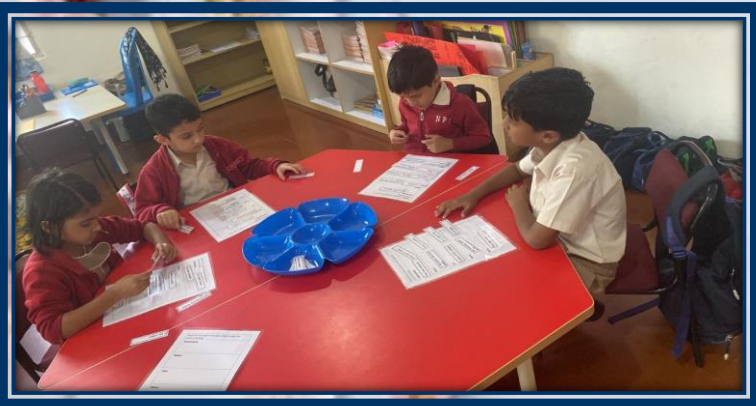


'What we learn with pleasure we never forget.'






'The two best days of school are the first and the last'
