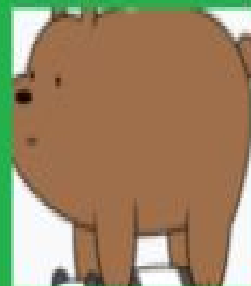

2. The True friends

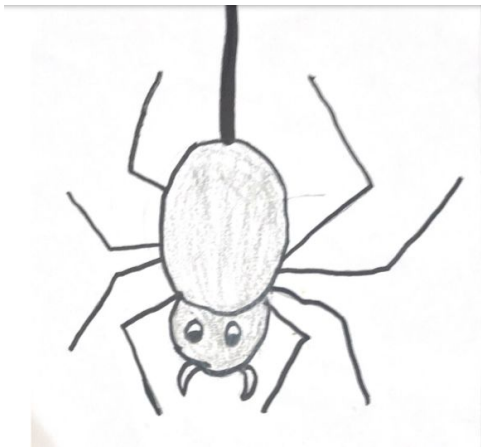

4. Never Lose Hope

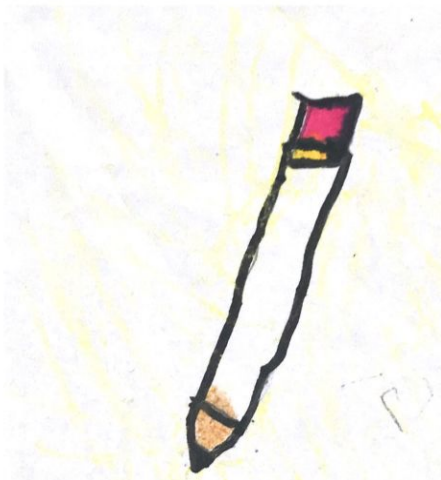
