We were able to excel as a school even in these difficult times, to a large extent, due to your unflinching support. We immensely thank and appreciate you for constantly being the buttress that strengthened our ecosystem. The pivotal role you played in enabling us to execute every aspect of the academic plan seamlessly, has further reinforced our belief that working in tandem with each other is the best way to ensure a brilliant present and a luminous future for our children.

Highlights of the year 2021-22

Unruffled by the hard times, the mantra of *carpe diem* stayed with our students. Their morale, augmented by a positive outlook and never-say-die attitude, helped them march ahead stolidly. In the process, their accomplishments expanded their horizons, while motivating their juniors to exceed their capabilities.

Here are some of the major achievements of our students:

- **Pranjal Srivastava** (Class of 2022) won Gold medal at the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO) 2021 held in St Petersburg, Russia.
- **Pranjal Srivastava (Class of 2022)** set the record by scoring full marks (200/ 200) at the national level (INOI) 3rd year in a row at the national level Olympiad (INMO 2021)
- **Pranjal Srivastava** (Class of 2022) also achieved a rare feat of representing the country and winning medals, in the same year, in the two largest Olympiads- IMO 2021 and IOI 2021 (The International Olympiad in Informatics) Pranjal has won a bronze in IOI 2021.
- Abhigyan Roy and Himank Gupta (Class of 2021) qualified in KVPY 2020.
- Saarang Srinivasan (Grade 12) was among the top 10 Indian students at the Indian National Informatics Olympiad winning gold medal. He was also among the top 33 students to qualify for the International Olympiad in Informatics Training Camp 2022.
- **Reyaansh Agrawal (Grade 6)** won gold medal and the Ramanujan Scholarship in the Junior Mathematics Olympiad (JMO) 2021
- Kushagra Sisodia (Grade 11), Akshaj Sharma (Grade 9) and Sreyan Panda (Grade 6) became published authors with Scholastic Quill Club Writers.

- **Pranjal Srivastava (Class of 2022)** became the only Indian to have gotten selected to represent India for the 16th KPMC (Korea Prime Minister Cup), a famous Go tournament.
- Prakaash Sarran (Grade 7) emerged number 1 in Karnataka U- 12 Boys in 2021.
- **Diya Agrawal (Grade 10)** secured the top 6th position in Asia in S.T. Yau High School Science Award in the chemistry category. She received a Certificate of Participation for reaching the third stage of assessment.
- **Diya Agrawal (Grade 10)** has also emerged the state winner for Karnataka in a competition INDIA@75: YOUTH IDEATHON 2021 organised by CBSE in collaboration with Management Entrepreneurship Professional Skills Council (MEPSC) under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship.
- Nand Vinchhi (Grade 11) is the recipient of Grand Award for his project in the category of SYSTEMS SOFTWARE (SOFT) at the Initiative for Research and Innovation in STEM (IRIS) National Fair 2022 which enables him to participate in the Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair, (ISEF) to be held at Atlanta, Georgia, USA from May 8-13, 2022.
- Sreejani Bhaduri (Grade 6) secured international rank-11 in the Indian School Talent Search Exam (ISTSE). She was awarded silver medal and certificate for being an Outstanding Performer.
- Laksh Bharani (Grade 11) released his first Android application called VaxiCheck on Google Play Store. The application effectively manages vaccination records over a long period of time.
- Siddharth Pereira (Grade 11) got one of his tracks (S!d, Anna-Sophia Henry Like A Man) played via Adept Records on two distinguished radio stations the first station, Indigo 91.9, which is based in Bangalore, and the second, BBC Radio
- **Riyansika Verma** (**Grade 6**) won Karnataka State Squash Championship in the girls under 13 (GU-13).
- Achyut Warrier (Grade 11) and Advik Kabra (Grade 11) cleared NTSE 2021.
