

Senior Observations and Parent Orientation

Parents of the Montessori Seniors were invited to observe their children at work during the 2nd week of July. The observation session was followed by an orientation conducted by the coordinators.

Having experienced the enthusiasm for learning and respectful demeanor of the children at class, which aligns perfectly with the Montessori philosophy, the parents were charged up to know how to support their children in their natural developmental planes. The coordinators shared some tips on how to encourage seniors to be selfdirected independent learners. All parents were in agreement that unstructured play, reading to children, uninterrupted sleep were essentials to help children focus better.









International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June. A special yoga class was designed for children which incorporated poses to increase strength, flexibility and coordination. Yoga was introduced to the children in a fun way by giving creative names for different yoga poses and including animal sounds to catch the attention of the little ones.



















On 20th July 2023, the Juniors and Seniors embarked on their maiden field trip to TISB. The purpose of the field trip was to provide students with an educational and enriching experience outside the classroom, allowing them to learn in a real-world setting and broaden their horizons.

Their excitement was palpable and the day ended with the tired but happy children being received by the parents at school.
