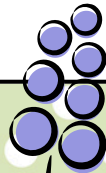
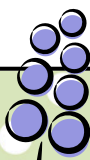
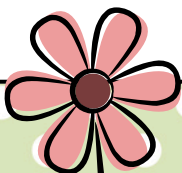
The classrooms became hubs of collaboration as students worked together on intricate collages. Our smallest artists appreciated the vast beauty of our heritage.

Different states, different names, but one spirit of joy.

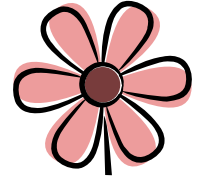

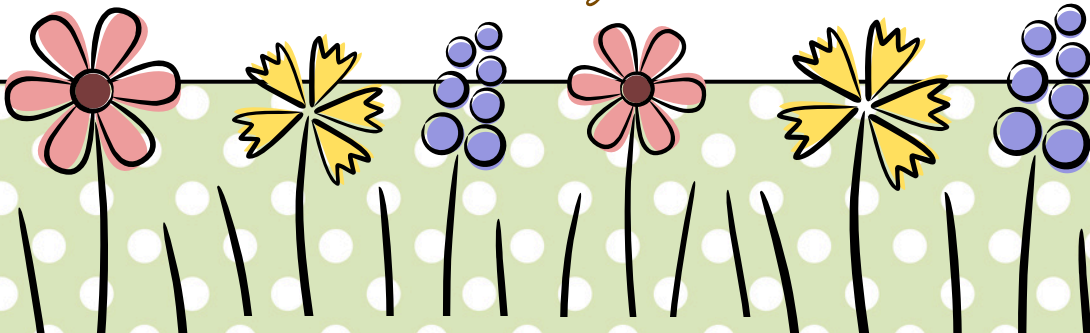
From boosting physical activity to sharpening sensory skills, it was an unforgettable day of learning through doing!

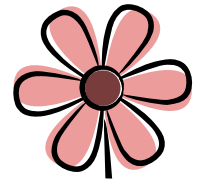

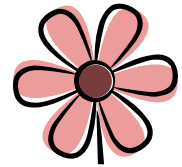

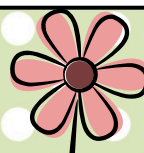


Republic Day Celebrations

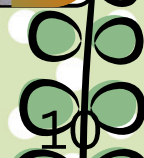
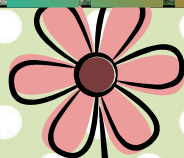
KG2 : In A Journey Through India

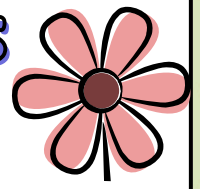

COOPERATION

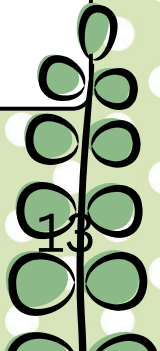



Individually, we are one drop. Together, we are an ocean.
