Responsibility



In the Montessori classroom, children are capable of taking on meaningful responsibility. Through age-appropriate tasks such as caring for materials, tidying workspaces, and helping peers, children develop independence, confidence, and respect for their environment. Guided by teachers and supported by a well-prepared classroom, responsibility becomes a natural part of daily work, helping children feel capable, valued, and connected to their community.

In addition, as the value in focus was Responsibility, children were given age-appropriate opportunities such as being assigned specific classroom chores. Some children took on the responsibility of teaching drawing, writing, and reading to their peers. The children also created a Responsibility Tree, where each leaf displayed a note describing the responsibility they had undertaken. This activity fostered a strong sense of responsibility, teamwork, reflection, and pride in their contributions.
